Membership Categories

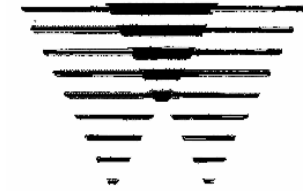
Branch Member – Maintains full membership through local branch in the State, Association and International Federation of University Women.
