

GIRLS TAKE CHARGE

The Girls Take Charge project builds on the Explorathon experience, an AAUW career exploration for 4th and 5th girls. Girls Take Charge increases Explorathon participants leadership and communications skills with a math and science emphasis. These skills will help the girls determine and develop their future careers.

**Partnering with Kellogg Community College (KCC), we provided four sessions with math/science focus. The first Girls Take Charge workshop focused on teamwork. The second workshop focused on creating and innovating, and during the third workshop participants created a product. They recorded measurements and ratios as well as documented how the creation was put together (a lab-type report). The fourth workshop focused on effective communications and presentation issues. The girls developed marketing materials to present their projects. Presenting and coaching reinforce and build communication skills.
