#### Membership Renewal

There are two ways to renew this year, by mail with a personal check, or online at aauw.org. The choice is yours.

By now you should have received an email from the branch with a printed renewal form. Please use this form if you decide to renew by personal check. Simply update your personal information on the form, enclose your check, and return it to the treasurer, **Nancy Connell**, 510 S Thompson St, Jackson, MI 49203.

You should have also received an email from the national office of AAUW with instructions about how to <u>renew online</u>. The process is straightforward, and pretty easy to complete. Simply go to AAUW.org, and sign in at the upper right-hand corner of the page. Sign in requires only a valid email address. If you haven't signed in before you'll be asked to create a password.

Once you're signed in you'll be on your "Personal Snapshot" page where you'll see a button at the bottom to Renew.

One note about online renewal. If you run into a problem DO NOT START OVER. Simply close out, and email <a href="mailto:connect@aauw.org">connect@aauw.org</a> for assistance.

No matter which way you renew, the information update form (which is also the renewal by check form) is there for everyone to complete and return to the treasurer.

Consider that you're doing it as a favor to the officers. If we receive a form from you, even if nothing has changed, we know the information for the bulletin and directory and the national and state rosters is correct. Without a form to confirm information, we're flying blind and sometimes making mistakes that don't turn up until something goes awry.

#### Public Policy – by Pattie Rayl

Public policy is an important component of the whole AAUW package. For Michiganders, there's good news as well as bad news. The good news is the recent passage of laws and proposed bills regarding topics on our advocacy list.

This includes Governor Whitmer's signing sensible gun laws requiring all guns be locked up in homes or places where children live/play. Also, bills were introduced in the Michigan House and Senate recently to set the minimum age to marry at 18.

The bad news is that, after 40 years, the U.S. Senate recently came up short in the vote to approve ending the time restrictions on the passage of the Equal Rights Amendment. The rules of the U.S. Senate means the 51-47 vote in support did not break the 60 filibuster mark. The bill was not voted out of the chamber.

I'm grateful to **Cecily Savick** for including me in the Jackson branch's public policy committee. I'm also grateful to **Ruth Brown** for allowing me to help on the state committee. My particular interest is the ERA, as I believe a lot of challenges in society will be addressed by adding the ERA to the U.S. Constitution.
